Course name	Helicopter Underwater Escape Training
Duration	1 day
Target group	Workers and professionals in the maritime and offshore segment, who use helicopter as transportation in their work activities.
Prerequisites	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- RG and CPF;</li> <li>- Passport (Expatriate);</li> <li>- Occupational Health Certificate (ASO) or certificate of good physical and mental health conditions.</li> </ul>
Objective	Provide knowledge and verify theoretical and practical competences of helicopter passengers, in aircraft emergency situations and abandonment, in the water or on land.
Contents	<p>The content of this training follows English (UK) standards, and covers the types of helicopters used offshore.</p> <p>Theory: 4h</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pre-shipment procedures;</li> <li>• Security procedures for shipment;</li> <li>• Procedures in flight;</li> <li>• Safety procedures for disembarkation;</li> <li>• Hazards associated with the helicopter;</li> <li>• Safety measures applied to helicopters;</li> <li>• Hazards in case of emergency landing;</li> <li>• Additional problems in case of water landing;</li> <li>• Preparation for emergency landing in the water;</li> <li>• Preparation for emergency ground landing;</li> <li>• Actions to be taken after emergency ground landing controlled;</li> <li>• Actions to be followed after controlled landing in the water.</li> </ul> <p>Practical: 4h</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Helicopter evacuation practice on the surface;</li> <li>• Submerged helicopter escape practice;</li> <li>• Submerged upside down with 180° overlap with window without stopping.</li> </ul>
